## Rest Haven Memorial Park Guidelines for Placement of Flowers

Rest Haven Memorial Park was established in 1970, according to the laws of the State of Texas. It provides an atmosphere of beauty and serenity, offering a permanent place for family and friends to gather in honor and remembrance of their loved ones.

As in any park, Rest Haven Memorial Park has set guidelines. We respectfully ask for your cooperation with the following, simple requirements in order to help provide a peaceful and welcoming setting for all who visit.

- Fresh cut flowers or artificial flowers may be placed on your property at any time throughout the year.
- All fresh cut flowers, artificial flowers, or personal memorabilia <u>must fit securely within</u> <u>the vase assembly</u> of your granite upright marker, flat bronze marker, or mausoleum arbor vase.
- Fresh cut flowers will be removed once they have lost their original beauty, and at the discretion of the Rest Haven Memorial Park Superintendent.
- Artificial flowers will be removed quarterly on the following dates:
  - March 28th
  - o June 28th
  - September 28<sup>th</sup>
  - o January 13th
- Artificial flower placements in honor of a birthday, death date, or anniversary that are in conflict with the quarterly removal dates described above may be adjusted by contacting the Rest Haven office.
- Fresh or artificial holiday greenery and flowers may be placed beginning the first week of December. Removal of all holiday items will begin the second week of January. During this time, holiday greenery and flowers *are permitted outside the vase assembly* of your marker.
- For the convenience of your family, Rest Haven has provided a storage building that is easily accessible at the south end of our maintenance warehouse. Shelving inside the storage building will be clearly marked with the name of each garden within the Park. Items removed from the grounds will be stored accordingly and available for you to pick up. After 30 days, they will be discarded. Holiday items will be stored through the end of January.
