She was quick, funny, easy-going - we roomed together for 3 weeks and we never had a crossword. I have so many wonderful memories. One in particular. We were stranded on Chizimulu Island due to high waves and high winds. We had no provisions or supplies. There were 7 women - among us we had 1 bar of soap, 1 roll of toilet paper, 1 bible, some crackers, 1 flashlight, and 1 package of bonine. Just enough to survive the night. I can still see her sitting on the mattress we shared on the floor, holding the flashlight reading a scripture from the Bible to encourage and uplift us. We spent a lot of time that night, laughing, sharing, and praising God. I will miss her quick smile and beautiful smile. But I will always hold them close in my memory.
