Born October 24, 1990, Danielle Britney Browning did not enter this world kicking and screaming, but she did come in fighting. By the time Danielle began school; she had experienced major medical complications and was staring down several more in her future. Each time Danielle fought through successfully, often defying doctor's bleak prognosis Danielle was a light of inspiration.

As a participant in San Diego State University's Child Development Program, Danielle was exposed to college students looking to embark on teaching careers. In this environment, she offered a jarring reality to the term Special Needs by being invited annually with her family to demonstrate the daily challenges of her life. Students, doctors, and future educators learned many lessons from Danielle; introspection, life lessons as well as practical skills that would change them and help them the rest of their lives. Danielle was a spark of motivation.

Upon moving to Royse City in 2005, she was part of the inaugural class of Rockwall Heath High School. During her eight years of rolling the halls of that campus, Danielle became somewhat of a celebrity, always receiving greetings from fellow students and teachers. Danielle was often recognized in public, her family being told by perfect strangers the tales of how they had come to know her. Despite her disabilities and struggles, Danielle did not allow you to feel sorry or pity her. Danielle was a glimmer of hope.

At the age of 25 Danielle claimed her independence to the heavens above on July 4, 2016. Danielle is survived by her parents, Trav and Barbara Browning, Brother: D. B. Browning III, Sister Gabrielle Browning, Great Aunt and Uncle Curt and Bonnie Oliver Aunt and Uncle Kimberly and John Yusunas Cousins Taylor and Tessa Yusunas, Grandfathers James Tichacek and Raymond Brochu; and many more loving cousins and dear friends. She is preceded in death by her Grandmothers: Mary Browning, Phyllis Phillips, and Junie Gelfand Brochu who are watching over her in heaven.
