



## Dr. Guy Olsen Keeter

March 26, 1934 - November 27, 2018

Guy Olsen Keeter, age 84, of Rockwall, TX, passed away Tuesday, November 27, 2018. He was born March 26, 1934, in Throckmorton, TX, to John J. and Leo (Allen) Keeter. Guy was the youngest of eight children and graduated from Throckmorton High School before attending Hardin Simmons University in Abilene, TX. While at Hardin Simmons, Guy met Jo Anne Yarbrough. Following graduation in 1955, they married and moved to Dallas for Guy to attend Baylor College of Dentistry. Guy practiced dentistry for 46 years and truly loved his patients and staff. He was very active in the Dallas County Dental Society, holding many positions and served as president in 1974.

In 1970, the Keeters moved to Rockwall. Guy served as a Deacon and a Sunday School teacher at First Baptist Church Rockwall. Most recently, he has been an active member at Lakepointe Church.

Dr. Keeter was preceded in death by his parents and siblings.
