



## Kyle B. Hale

June 26, 1942 - August 23, 2018

Kyle B. Hale, of Forney, TX, passed away August 23, 2018, at the age of 76. He was born June 26, 1942, in Odessa, TX, to Joe Bailey and Willie Mae (Cummings) Hale. Kyle served his country proudly in the United States Army during the Vietnam era. While he was a member of the Mesquite Police Department, he attended and graduated from the FBI Academy. He served his community for 31 years as a Mesquite Police Officer. As a member of the FBI National Association and the Texas Police Association, Kyle prided himself on helping others.
