Lisa Jeanne (Maercklein) Greenwood, 60, of Fate, Texas, passed from this life on April 29, 2021. Lisa was born to Dennis Bryan Maercklein and Mary (Houston) Reed, on August 27, 1960, in Orlando, Florida. Lisa was a member at Lakepointe Church in Rockwall, Texas.
